1. Scale:

2-octave A Major Scale. (Concert G Major) Play twice: first time legato, and second time staccato. Quarter note = 84.Check the key signature!



2. Required excerpt: Dance of the Tumblers, m 27-44 // Quarter note = 120

Check the key signature! Pay attention to and follow the marked articulations (accents, slurs, staccatos), breath marks, and dynamics. Start at letter D (as marked) and play until the end of the excerpt shown. (measure 44.)
